

• On November 14th, 1903, working-class women and Progressive Era reformers founded the National Women's Trade Union League (NWTUL) in Boston at the convention of the American Federation of Labor. The stated purpose of the new organization, according to its founders, was to "assist in the organization of women wage workers into trade unions and thereby to help them secure conditions necessary for healthful and efficient work and to obtain a just reward for such work."
