This Week in Labor History:

On December 10th, 1948, seventy years ago today, the United Nations General Assembly adopted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Articles 23 and 24 of the Declaration pertain to the rights of workers. They assert, among other things that “everyone has the right to form and to join trade unions for the protection of his interests;” and that “everyone has the right to rest and leisure, including reasonable limitation of working hours and periodic holidays with pay.” Interestingly, former first lady Eleanor Roosevelt played a central role in the drafting of the Declaration.
