On May 15th, 1891, Pope Leo XIII issued the encyclical *Rerum Novarum*, which staunchly defended the right of workers to organize in order to achieve improved wages and working conditions. According to the encyclical, “We may lay it down as a general and lasting law that working men’s associations should be so organized and governed as to furnish the best and most suitable means for attaining what is aimed at, that is to say, for helping each individual member to
